3 Divisions: Junior – 15 and under / Middle – 16 to 20 / Senior - 21 and over

Driver Eligibility

- Drivers must be 18 years of age or older
- Drivers who are 16 and 17 years of age must have signed parental permission handed in to the judges before event starts.
- All drivers must sign a release discharging the Revitalization Of Youngsville (ROY), the Borough of Youngsville (BOY) and the Youngsville Volunteer fire department from liability.
- Drivers must pay the entry fee of \$5.00 and have your mower approved.

Mower Eligibility

- Events are open to all self-propelled rotary or reel style riding lawn mowers.
- The mower must originally have been designed and sold commercially to mow lawns.
- The mower must remain suitable for lawn cutting.

Mower Requirements

- CUTTING BLADES MUST BE REMOVED COMPLETELY FROM ALL MOWERS.
- All mowers must be equipped with an engine safety cut-off switch.
- Mower brakes must be in good condition, operating on at least 2 wheels.
- Fuel must be pump gas. The only additive allowed is STA-BIL Fuel Stabilizer.

Driver Safety Equipment

- Drivers must wear an automobile racing or motorcycle-type safety helmet.
- Drivers shall wear long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, gloves and shoes on the track.

TRACK Rules

- 1) No driver who has consumed any alcoholic beverage on the day of an event may participate in a race.
- 2) NO BUMPING WILL BE TOLERATED
- 3) Driver must keep both hands on the steering wheel, except to momentarily operate other controls
- 4) Mower must be completely stopped before driver dismounts.
- 5) Unsafe on track/off-track driving practices may result in disqualification.
